**FINALBORGO AND NOLI: A JOURNEY BACK TO THE MIDDLE AGES**
**Description**

Centuries of history and suggestive settings transport us back in time to the Middle Ages as we explore two of Italy's most handsome medieval townships, Finalborgo and Noli.

**What we will see**

- Finalborgo
- Castel San Giovanni
- Basilica of San Biagio
- Convent of Santa Caterina
- Noli
- The *Torre del Canto* and the *Torre del Comune*
- Medieval walls
- Cathedral of San Paragorio

**What we will do**

- We leave the port by coach, in the company of our tour rep, and make our way to the first stop on our journey, **Finalborgo**, which is considered one of the most attractive townships in the whole of Italy. The settlement is undoubtedly medieval in origin, although recent research suggests that it was founded several centuries earlier than was previously believed.
- As we stroll through the streets of the old town, the imposing defensive mass of **Castel San Giovanni** and other notable monuments such as the **Basilica of San Biagio**, the **Convent of Santa Caterina** and numerous Renaissance *palazzi* conjure an almost palpable sense of history.
- We leave Finalborgo for another of the Italian Riviera's Medieval gems: the town of **Noli**. This gracious little settlement was home to skilled merchants and courageous navigators who saw it become an independent maritime republic.
- We explore the historic centre on foot, admiring the buildings that recount this fascinating history. There are the **Torre del Canto and the Torre del Comune**, two of the "seventy-two towers of Noli", of which but a few remain. Then there are the surviving **sections of the defensive walls** that once formed an impenetrable barrier around the city, and the 12th-century **Cathedral of San Paragorio**, one of the emblematic examples of Romanesque architecture in Liguria.

We are taking a journey back in time in a fascinating village, where history is everywhere: Seborga, a self-proclaimed principality in the fifties, lives its special status daily, amidst characteristic alleyways, beautiful period palaces and panoramic views.

**What we will see**

- Italian Riviera
- Seborga
- A stroll through the village
- Church of San Martino and the Palazzo dei Monaci

- We leave Savona and make our way southwards along the splendid **Italian Riviera**, with impressive hills alternating with characteristic village, cliffs and famous beaches.
- We arrive at our destination: the Ligurian village of **"Seborga"**, perched on the crest of a hill, from which you can enjoy panoramic views of the vegetation-covered mountains and beaches lapped by a turquoise sea.
- We'll stroll through the village alleyways, where the **typical atmosphere of an ancient village** reigns, amidst majestic houses, small gardens and historic monuments.
- What makes Seborga even more fascinating is its unusual **self-proclamation as principality** in the fifties, even going as far as to elect a prince, although with merely symbolic functions.
- The entire life of the village **bears signs of this original status**: along the streets we find cars with a special licence plate next to the official number plate, in the shops we can purchase using "Luigini" coins issued by the principality, and the houses fly the official, blue and white striped flag.
- As we plunge into this haunting atmosphere, we cannot fail to admire the **monuments in the town centre**, such as the splendid Baroque church of San Martino or the Palazzo dei Monaci which, in the 17th century, housed the mint which issued the Luigini coins.
- Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

**Description**

The Principality of Monaco is one of the smallest independent States in the world but despite its size it offers an incredible variety of attractions, all to be discovered: from the ancient city, to the Casinos, to the Formula 1 circuit.





**What we will see**

- Monaco Ville: Royal Palace square, Cathedral
- Monte Carlo: Casino, boutiques

**What we will do**

- To get to our destination, we will take the coach along the Fiori motorway, offering a suggestive glimpse of some typical Ligurian villages.
- After crossing the French border, we will arrive in the Principality of Monaco, one of the smallest independent states in the world, its origins and history are indelibly linked to the Grimaldi family, who have ruled here for over 700 years. More specifically, Prince Rainier III who reigned from 1949 to 2005, strongly supported the development of the Principality. Owing to his fairy-tale marriage to the American actress Grace Kelly and the numerous initiatives he supported, the Rainier lineage made this tiny State one of the most frequented by international jet-setters, turning it into a place where numerous world events are held, some of which, delightfully for charity.
- Our tour begins with **Monaco Ville**, the ancient city, which expands over a rock fortified in a very appealing position overlooking the sea. Here, we will have the opportunity to admire the **Royal Palace square** and, dependent on the arrival time, we may witness the changing of the guard.
- The excursion will lead us to the small **Cathedral**, the final resting place of both Prince Rainier and his beloved wife, Princess Grace, who was tragically killed in a car accident that is still shrouded in mystery.
- Late morning, we will make our way, by coach, to the most well known part of the principality, **Monte Carlo**, with its **Casinos**, luxury hotels, sophisticated lifestyle and the streets that, once a year, provide the course for the celebrated Monaco Grand Prix. We can use the free time available as we like, to go on a pleasant walk or shop in the boutiques which offer the most well-known brand labels in the world.

We will immerse into the undersea world in one of the largest aquariums in Europe, an unmissable attraction located within the charming area of the Ancient Port, which we will be able to also admire from the sea thanks to the wonderful boat ride.

**What we will do**

- We will arrive, by coach, to the expo area where **Genoa Aquarium**, one of the most important in Europe, is found. We will immerse ourselves into the multifaceted and colourful submarine wildlife where we will discover tropical fish boasting thousands of colours, sponges and jellyfish, natural corals, sharks with ice-cold stares and the wonderful dolphins, seals and penguins. A genuine, unique and unforgettable "tour of the seas of the World".  
At the end of the visit, we will hop on board the boat to admire Genoa and its lively port from a privileged viewpoint. Subsequently, we will have some free time to wander around the area of the **Ancient Port**. Passing by the former **Cotton Stores**, which have now been renovated and turned into shops, bars and restaurants, we can admire **Bigo**, a unique building designed by the famous Genoese architect, Renzo Piano which, together with Lanterna, is seen, by the Genoese people, as one of the most characteristic symbols of the ancient city, named "Superba".  
Steeped in the wonder of what we have seen, we will now return to the coach and get back on the motorway to Savona.

**ANCIENT GENOA: PORT, HISTORIC CENTRE AND A NEW ROADWAY AMONGST WONDERS AND FLAVOURS**
**Description**

Upon the discovery of the heart of the historic centre of Genoa, amongst its sumptuous buildings and flavours.

**What we will see**

- Lanterna, Castelletto
- Via Garibaldi, Palazzo Rosso, House of Columbus, Porta Soprana
- Ducal Palace, Imperial Palace, Ancient Port, Via San Lorenzo, Porticoes of Sotto Ripa

**What we will do**

- Taking a scenic route on the motorway along the coast of **Riviera di Ponente**, we will arrive in Genoa, glimpses of the sea and the Mediterranean scrubland included.
- Skimming the port, we will admire Lanterna, which has always been a point of reference for seafarers, and we will continue, by coach, upon the discovery of the most interesting places within the city until we get to **Castelletto**, one of the oldest and aristocratic in Genoa which stands on the headland overlooking the historic centre.
- From here one of the city's historic lifts will take us to the very centre, to the alleyways which Rubens described as "Europe's most beautiful roads": **Via Garibaldi**, better known as Strada Nuova. This pedestrian area includes some of Genoa's most sumptuous squares, built in the 1500s as residences for the most important noble families and which were restored to their original splendour for the occasion of "Genoa 2004".
- At this stage, we will visit the **Palazzo Rosso and Palazzo Imperiale** (exclusive entry for Costa Cruises) followed by a delicious tasting session.
- From this elegant alleyway, we will go onto a part of the city which historically connected it to the sea, passing by **Porta Soprana**, the **House of Columbus**, **Via San Lorenzo**, the **Ducal Palace** and the **Ancient Port**.
- During the free time available until the end of the tour, we can trace the ancient and characteristic **Porticoes of Sotto Ripa**.
- The transfer to Genoa takes approximately 1 hour.

- We stop at the **Parc Ornithologique du Pont de Gau**, which combines the joy of a stroll with the discovery of the bird species living in the region such as graceful flamingoes, once on the brink of extinction, herons, egrets and storks.
- We walk along paths, footbridges and walkways on a **guided tour** of the park, which covers 60 hectares of unspoilt nature where flora and fauna coexist in harmony in their natural habitat. *After the visit, we leave the park and head towards the capital of Camargue, Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer\**, a small fishing village with white houses dominated by a relaxed evocative atmosphere.
- Here, we have some free time to **explore the town**. We can wander around the shops, enjoy local specialities or visit the town sights before returning to the ship.

**What we will do**

- We leave the port of Marseille by coach, and head for **Avignon**, a journey that takes about one hour. The city of Avignon is famous for having been the seat of the Papacy from 1309 to 1377, a period known as the Avignon captivity . Pope Clement V transferred the Papal court from Rome to Avignon, from where 7 Popes reigned until 1377 and 2 antipopes stayed on almost until the end of the 14th century, bringing a period of prominence and prosperity to the city.
- Our tour takes us to the **Palace of the Popes** which has been recognised in France as a historic monument since 1840, and as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995. The building, which is both a palace and a fortress, is one of the most extraordinary examples of Gothic architecture of the 14th century. It was built in two phases, by two popes: to the north, the more austere Palais Vieux (Old Palace) was built during the reign of Benedict XII; the Palais Neuf (New Palace), to the south, was built by his successor, Clement VI. Inside, the now-empty galleries, chambers and chapels give an apparent impression of austerity. The frescoes and handwoven tapestries in the bedrooms and the Papal study however, give a better idea of the pomp and splendour of times gone by.
- Before going back to the ship, we have some free time for a walk in the streets of the centre or for shopping.

- We will then make our way to the **Church of Saint-Laurent**, a handsome example of Provençal Romanesque architecture, built in pink stone from Couronne, with splendid views of the Old Port.
- It also marks the beginning of the quarter known as **Le Panier** ("the basket"), which is one of the oldest quarters of Marseille and the old heart of the city. It owes its name to the Le Logis du Panier inn, an old establishment dating back to the 17th century. This part of the city is a typical Mediterranean port neighbourhood with the fronts of houses painted in a variety of colours and narrow winding streets. Historically a favoured haunt of sailors, it is now one of Marseille's most characteristic areas.
- Following a visit to **La Vieille Charité** originally an almshouse for the city's poor, now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions we have the opportunity to try a local speciality, the navette (little boat), a traditional biscuit flavoured with orange blossoms that is baked in the shape of a boat.
- After a short break, close to La Vieille Charité, we pay a short visit to the Neo-Byzantine **Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure** also known by the locals as La Major before heading back to the port.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.

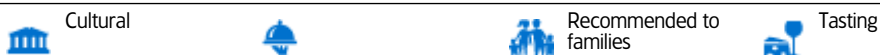

- We then make our way to the new **museum complex**, which comprises three institutions: the Musée Regards de Provence, the Ville Méditerranée and MuCEM the Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilisations. Our guide will provide an overview of each building from the outside.
- We walk onwards, heading into the old heart of the city, the **Panier** quarter, with its artisan workshops and colourful, bustling cafés.
- Before we make our way into the web of narrow streets of the old town, we stop to visit the courtyard and the loggia of **La Vieille Charité**, a building that originally served as an almshouse for the city's poor, but which is now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions. We then take another short break to sample the famous panissa, a sort of cake made with just a few humble ingredients: chickpea flour, water and salt.
- We make our way back to the Old Port, where we can either board the ship straight away, or spend a couple of hours of free time in the city centre.

- Our adventure begins with a **sightseeing coach tour of Rome's ancient ruins**, which even today lend the centre of the city an air of majesty and prestige.
- Our route takes us past such wonders as the **Pyramid of Cestius**, a funeral monument built in the Egyptian style in the 1st century BC, the **Baths of Caracalla**, the grandest thermal complex of the imperial age, the **Circus Maximus**, where the crowds once flocked to watch the chariot races.
- We leave our coach for a guided tour of the **church of San Pietro in Vincoli** (Saint Peter in Chains), which is home to a Michelangelo masterpiece, a statue of Moses.
- Next, we stop to **take a photo or two at the Colosseum**, perhaps the most famous monument in Rome and an absolute must-see on our visit to the city. From there, we begin a walking tour along the **via dei Fori Imperiali**, where the ancient imperial capital seems to come back to life. This leads us to the feet of the Capitoline Hill and **Piazza Venezia**, on whose southern side towers "Il Vittoriano" the imposing monument to King Victor Emmanuel II.
- At this point, we may be beginning to feel a little languorous, so what better time to take a seat for some deliciously authentic Italian cooking with **lunch at a local restaurant?**
- Suitably restored, we head back out on foot, this time focusing on the treasures of Baroque Rome: we pass the **Trevi Fountain**, with the ever-present throngs of tourists, and the Palazzo Montecitorio, a glorious example of Roman Baroque, which overlooks the piazza of the same name, and which is now the seat of the Chamber of Deputies, one of the two houses of the

Italian Parliament. Finally, we reach **Piazza Navona**, with the splendid fountain designed by the great sculptor and architect Gian Lorenzo Bernini.

- Our last stop is the Vatican City, where the two semi-circles of the colonnade designed by Bernini embrace the circular piazza and frame the façade and huge dome of the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica.

The transfer to Rome takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes.

The guide will join the excursion group once we reach Rome.

- From the port of Civitavecchia, we make our way to the capital of Italy for a **sightseeing tour of Rome**, on which we visit some of the less-well-known sites in the imperious “eternal city”.
- From the comfort of our coach, we see the **Baths of Caracalla** – the grandest thermal bath complex of the imperial age, not to mention one of the best-preserved in all the Empire – and the **Circus Maximus**, which was used in ancient times for various sporting spectacles but which is most famous for its chariot races.

At the Aventine Hill, we leave the coach briefly to visit a little-known attraction, the **keyhole at the Villa del Priorato di Malta**. As we peer through a hole in the gate, we are treated to a splendid view of the dome of St. Peter’s at the end of a long, tree-lined boulevard.

Here, we visit the Basilica of **Santa Maria in Trastevere**, which was probably the first official Christian place of worship to be built in Rome. The interior includes some splendid mosaics from the 12th and 13th centuries.

Our guide then leads us on foot through the **Jewish Ghetto** which, between the years 1555 and 1870, was the only part of Rome where Jews were permitted to live. Today, it is a popular, lively area where fascinating monuments stand side-by-side with sophisticated restaurants.

We pass through the **Campo dei Fiori** – which hosts a local market during the day, but becomes a bustling social hub in the evening – before emerging into **Piazza Navona**, with its opulent baroque buildings and splendid fountains.

We admire the baroque church of **Santa Maria della Pace**, and the Gothic **Santa Maria dell’Anima**, before taking some free time for lunch, which we can enjoy wherever we fancy.

After lunch, our guided walking tour continues with a visit to the **Pantheon**, originally a temple dedicated to the Emperor Hadrian and all the Roman gods, and we visit the Basilica of **Santa Maria Sopra Minerva**, which offers a rare example of Gothic art in Rome.

We end our walk with paying homage to the celebrated **Trevi Fountain**, where visitors gather from all over the world to throw the customary coin into the water, and the equally famous **Piazza di Spagna** with its monumental “Spanish Steps”.

The transfer to Rome takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes.

The guide will join the excursion group once we reach Rome.

This excursion involves about 2 hours of walking. Comfortable shoes are strongly recommended.



This excursion is not available to passengers who are leaving the ship at Civitavecchia.

This excursion is not recommended for guests with limited mobility.

We recommend that you book early as only a limited number of places are available.

- For those who love more unusual experiences, don't miss out on a fascinating tour of **underground Orvieto**, created over the course of approximately 2,500 years by its ancient inhabitants and featuring uninterrupted excavations dotted with wells, caves and indescribably intriguing settings.
- Orvieto is also a lovely place to **stroll around the shops**, passing elegant buildings and charming streets which open up every now and then to reveal breathtaking views of the surrounding valley.
- After our free time, we will gather at the meeting point to return to the ship by coach.
- This excursion does not include a guide, but we will have the assistance of a local rep.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- The cost of food and entrance tickets to tourist sites is not included in the price of the excursion.

## ROME AND ST. PETER

### Description

This excursion retraces the main stages of the long history of Rome, the cradle of civilization and Christianity, an amazing city with immense historical, artistic and spiritual wealth.

### What we will see

- Colosseum
- Trevi Fountain
- Pantheon
- Piazza Navona
- St. Peter's Square and St. Peter's Basilica

### What we will do

- When we arrive in Rome, we begin our visit with a sightseeing tour of the city (by coach) that takes us to some of Rome's most famous monuments including the magnificent **Colosseum**, built by the Emperors of the Flavian dynasty for public entertainment. We leave the coach to admire this symbolic monument of ancient Rome from the exterior and we continue on foot.
- Our itinerary takes us to the **Trevi Fountain**, a magnificent Baroque monument that attracts visitors to the Eternal City and is also famous for the custom of throwing coins into the water with your back to the fountain: one to make sure you return to Rome and a second one to make a wish.
- The tour proceeds to the **Pantheon**, one of the best preserved monuments of Antiquity, built by the Emperor Hadrian in honour of all the gods.
- Our next stop is **Piazza Navona**, one of the landmarks of the city, which is still steeped in the atmosphere of the times when it was the scene of circus games in 17th century Rome. Here we have free time for lunch.
- Our main destination awaits us in the afternoon: **St. Peter's Square** with its magnificent Basilica. We stop to observe the colonnade designed by Bernini that embraces the circular area of the square framing the façade of the Basilica and its huge dome.
- In our free time we can visit **St. Peter's Basilica**, the symbol of the Vatican State, built on the tomb of St. Peter. Inside there are priceless treasures of art including the *Pietà*, the magnificent marble statue by Michelangelo.
- After a last look at the heart of Christianity and after taking another few photos with which to remember it we return to the coach that takes us back to the ship.

**THE MEDIEVAL JEWEL OF TARQUINIA AND THE MYSTERIOUS ETRUSCAN CULTURE**
**Description**

An extraordinary journey of discovery in the area around Tarquinia, where the mysterious Etruscan people lived for centuries, leaving behind artefacts of rare beauty. Tarquinia is also a fascinating medieval hamlet and we do not miss this opportunity to discover its treasures and secrets.

### What we will see

- Historical centre of Tarquinia
- Church of *Santa Maria in Castello*
- Fortified tower of the Countess Matilda of Canossa, *Piazza delle Erbe* and the Barucci Tower
- Etruscan Necropolis of Tarquinia and the National Etruscan Museum
- Lunch with dishes of the ancient Etruscan tradition.

### What we will do

- We leave the port and head for **the ancient city of Corneto, today's Tarquinia**, an architectural and historical jewel within the medieval walls of a charming hamlet that has been nicknamed the "San Gimignano" of the Latium region because of its numerous towers.
- We leave the coach and wander through the alleys and hidden corners of the historic centre to discover an unexpected and exciting world that is not only made of the particular bricks with their unmistakable colour - the colour of *macco*, a unique local building material - but also of fascinating stories, legends and anecdotes.
- Romanesque, Gothic and Neoclassical architectural styles are almost unwittingly intertwined on the façades of the palazzi and churches, including the splendid **church of *Santa Maria in Castello*** which towers in isolation on the edge of the hill.
- Evoking memories, mysteries and surprises, our walk takes us to the **Fortified Tower of the Countess Matilda of Canossa**, a jewel set in fortification walls that are well worth viewing, *Piazza delle Erbe*, dominated by the **Barucci Tower** at the foot of which the executioner carried out his grim rituals in Medieval times.
- And then we come to more alleys, coats of arms, cloisters and medieval towers: a perfect setting which evokes a time when hoards of monks beguiled rich and poor, the powerful and the destitute in their attempt to address their needs and forecast their destiny.
- Our lunch break becomes a way to continue our encounter with this magical land steeped in history. Indeed, Tarquinia is also the cradle of the Etruscan civilization and at the restaurant we are served **typical local dishes** which have been handed down from the Etruscan culinary tradition.
- We continue to be spellbound at the **Necropolis of Tarquinia**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where we have the opportunity to see some of the most beautiful painted tombs that have made this archaeological site famous
- To complete our journey through Etruscan culture which, in many ways is still unknown, we go to the Palazzo Vitelleschi which today houses the **National Etruscan Museum**, where we can relive the fascinating world of this Tyrrhenian people by admiring the precious exhibits on display.

Please note: Space is limited, so please book early. The excursion is mainly a stroll on a medieval path, so comfortable walking shoes are recommended. The order of the itinerary may vary.
